


BOOKS ABOUT GOD

What If I Can't Explain God? focuses on a young girl who struggles to understand what God is, no matter how much the grown-ups in her life try to explain. She ends up contemplating other mysteries through which she discovers more about God.

Some of the protagonist's greatest confusion comes from what adults will recognize as the concept of the trinity. As she reflects, she discovers that it makes sense that if God is three-in-one, then it makes sense to refer to God as "They." God is consistently referred to with they/them pronouns throughout the rest of the story.
